Landscape archaeology in the territories of Usellus and Villa Verde (west central Sardinia)

The SurveyLab is addressed to graduate and undergraduate students who wish to deepen the main aspects (ground surface surveys, topographic modeling, geomorphology, applications of GIS to archaeology) of Landscape Archaeology. The undergraduate students should have already taken an introductory archaeology course.

Located in the territories of Usellus and Villa Verde, in the west central Sardinia, 100 hours of both lectures and lab activities will provide a updated and comprehensive approach to the domain of landscape archaeology.

Fieldwork (archaeological survey, documentation of proto-historic and historic sites, ceramic cataloging) encompasses some of the principal topics of the archaeological landscape studies.

The intact and wild Usellus and Villa Verde landscape, about 20 kilometers from the sea, gives the opportunity to experience the beauties and the thousand years old culture of the Sardinian land.
