




Alteritas TRAINING SCHOOL

Alteritas is glad to announce the Training School "Tools for the study of ancient populations and their interactions". The TS is targeted to under-graduate, graduate students and PhE candidates of Classics, Archaeology, Prehistory and Ancient History, as well as early caree investigators of neighbouring disciplines, who are interested to deepen their knowledge and tools on the study of the past, with a special focus on interactions among ancient populations. The school provides training on subjects usually not covered by university career, though founding complements to the study of the ancient world. Disciplines such as: Ethno archaeology, Dendrochronology and Dendroprovenance, Underwater Archaeology Archaeometry and Archaeology of Production, Archaeological Forensic Facial Reconstruction Seriation Tools for Archaeology and Epigraphy, Introduction to Corpus Language Databases PC-tools for Humanities will be offered in the form of a full immersion training, 6-7 Hours/day Official language of the School will be English. Lectures in Italian will be also given.


The fee of 800 € is comprehensive of training (i.e. access to all lectures and support material) full accommodation at the Seminario Vescovile in Verona from Sunday 2 to Friday 7 September 2018 and two city excursions.
