The Scientific Meeting will be articulated in the following sessions:

1. Climate, environment and man
2. Dissemination and migration of populations, groups and individuals
3. Hunters and gatherers: subsistence, territory, ideology
4. Technologies: producers, recipients and users.
5. From the first forms of inequality to the first forms of state and proto-urban organizations
6. Differences and contaminations in networks and borders

Furthermore, cultural anthropologists, physical anthropologists and archaeologists will present examples, models, research methods on particular themes for the multidisciplinary comparison in key-notes held within the sessions.

A discussant will moderate the debate on issues raised by communications at the end of each session.

The deadline for submission for both podium and poster presentations to the Secretariat of the Scientific Meeting (riunsc2019@gmail.com) is **January 31, 2019**.

To facilitate the evaluation of submitted proposals by the Scientific Committee, it is recommended that abstract be at least 2,000 characters in length and that they clearly outline the contents of the proposed presentation.

It should be noted that synthetic communications will be preferred, while limited case studies should be presented as posters

The communications will be published in paper format in the series *Studi di Preistoria e Protostoria* of the IIPP. The posters will be published in digital format.

After the Scientific Meeting, all contributions submitted for publication will be subjected to peer review.
