Copper Age and Early Bronze burials: new discoveries

In the last few years, new important discoveries of funerary sites dated to the Copper Age and the Early Bronze Age have been made in various regions of Italy. Although these contexts are still unpublished, it seems that they can provide significant progress to our knowledge of rituals, funerary architectures, and more in general of cultural aspects of 3rd and 2nd millennium BC.

In order to encourage the scientific debate on these topics, the Istituto Italiano di Preistoria e Protostoria, in collaboration with the Soprintendenza archeologia, belle arti e paesaggio per le province di Verona, Rovigo e Vicenza, aims to organize a meeting on unpublished funerary contexts dated between the 3rd and 2nd millennium BC. Primary importance will be also given to the methodological approaches applied to excavation and material analysis.

The meeting will be articulated in:

- Maximum 30 minutes talks on unpublished contexts, addressing the themes of rituals, funerary architectures, grave goods, osteological data, radiocarbon dates, archaeometric analyses (e.g. isotopes, organic residual analyses, aDNA)
- Posters, in print and digital format, related to specific aspects or to new results regarding already known contexts.
- Broad discussion

Depending on the number of paper proposals, the meeting will be structured in one or two days.

We invite the scholars who intend to participate to send an 3.000-5.000 words abstract (both in Italian and English) at the email address iapp.verona2021@gmail.com by March 15th, 2021. The abstract should include information about the main characteristics of the site, the chronological assessment, the general state of the research, and maximum 3 figures with captions (in Italian and English).

An abstract book will be published on the website of the Istituto Italiano di Preistoria e Protostoria (www.iipp.it), but no publication of the proceedings is planned.
