NEMESIS is an International Network of archaeologists working on the Iron Age funded by CNRS. It was founded to facilitate discussions and exchanges in order to boost the preparation of research programs of international scope.

NEMESIS offers grants to facilitate study trips within the European area. These grants are for researchers and student researchers. For this first call, four grants are envisaged.

The purpose of the trip must be related to the NEMESIS themes, which are detailed on the website https://irnnemesis.hypotheses.org/

The stay must be scheduled between 1 November 2022 and 28 February 2023.

NEMESIS will cover travel and accommodation costs up to a maximum of €1,000. Reservations and payment of services will be made by BIBRACTE.

They should include a CV, a letter of intent and an invitation (in English or French). The letter of intent will outline the purpose of the visit. A short report should be sent at the end of the mission.

The selection committee will meet at the end of September for a communication of the results at the beginning of October 2022.
